MAX COBB

Max Cobb was a member of the IBU Executive Board from 2016-22, until he was appointed IBU Secretary General in August 2022. Previously, he served as IBU Vice President Sport between 2016 and 2018. His work as President and CEO of US Biathlon began in 1989 as the head of the domestic race series after being an active biathlon club competitor at Dartmouth College. In 1990, he was named Assistant Coach and Manager of the National Team, and in 1994 he became Program Director. Elected to the IBU's Technical Committee (TC) in 2002, he was the chairman from 2010-2016.







FABIAN WOLFSPERGER

Born in Freiburg im Breisgau, Germany, Fabian finished his dissertation at the Karlsruhe Institute of Technology (KIT) Institute for Applied Materials focused on friction on snow. He also has a degree in Sports Engineering from the Otto-von-Guericke University in Magdeburg (GER). Since 2009, Fabian has been a Scientific Staff Member at the WSL Institute for Snow and Avalanche Research (SLF) in Davos, Switzerland. At the SLF, Fabian's research focus is on snow in the context of winter sports, tourism and industrial applications.







ERIK MELIN SÖDERSTRÖM

Erik is a Climate and Snow Expert at Peak 63, in Östersund, Sweden. A former competitive cross-country skier he has a love for snow and a keen interest in climate change. With a master's degree in climate change from studies in Alaska and Copenhagen, Erik has great knowledge about the effects of climate change on winter and snow dependent activities, how these can adapt to climate change and reduce their climate impact.







JAN SKŘIČKA

Jan has worked for the Nové Město na Moravě IBU World Cup in the Czech Republic since 2012. From 2015, he has served as Executive Director of the Vysočina Arena for biathlon and cross-country skiing. A former member of the Czech national team in orienteering, Jan also has extensive experience in the organisation of mountain biking events as well as in communication and public relations for the cycling industry. He holds a degree in marketing and media communication from the Tomáš Baťa University in Zlín, the Czech Republic.







DR FABIANO MONTI

Fabiano is a passionate mountain and snow lover. He studied environmental sciences at the Insubria University in Como and completed his PhD at the WSL Institute for Snow and Avalanche Studies SLF in Davos, Switzerland. He has also worked as a researcher for Insubria and CNR-IFAC in Florence, an experience that allowed him to participate in two Antarctic campaigns. After moving to Livigno he founded Alpsolut where is the CEO. Fabiano likes to use theoretical knowledge to solve concrete issues related to the world of snow and, more generally, to the environment.







JANEZ OZBOLT

A former elite biathlete, Janez competed at five consecutive Winter Olympic Games from 1992 until 2006. After his long career, he has remained active in biathlon as an official and coach, and most recently as part of the Organizing Committee in Pokljuka as well as an IBU Official. Janez holds a master's degree in management from the University of Primorska in Koper, Slovenia.







KINGA JAWOREK

Currently Sport Director at the Lower Silesian Sport Centre Polana Jakuszycka (Lower Silesian Innovation and Science Park), Kinga has been working to develop Jakuszyce as an international biathlon and cross-country skiing venue since 2005. She served as an organiser of the popular cross-country skiing events Bieg Piastów and Worldloppet until 2016 while also serving as a Worldloppet Executive Board Member from 2012-2016. From 2016, she has participated in the development of the Biathlon and Cross Country Skiing Centre in Jakuszyce and has organised countless cross-country skiing and biathlon, running, cycling competitions, both national and international, including the FIS Cross Country World Cup and IBU Junior Cup events. She is a biathlon and Nordic sport activist, a FIS Technical Delegate, and an IBU International Referee.

Kinga has a master's degree in Neerlandistiek/Dutch Studies and postgraduate studies in managing external and European Funds at the University of Wroclaw, Poland.







LARS LIND ANDREASEN

With a bachelor's degree in German and history, a career in sales wasn't Lars's plan. Marlen is Head of Strategic Projects at Swiss-Ski, where she is responsible for projects related to the topics of ethics, sustainability, and gender equality. She is also President of the Snowstainability.ch foundation that was founded in 2022 to raise funds to support and promote projects that seek to implement concrete solutions to sustainability challenges in snow sports. Marlen earned her PhD in Sport Sciences from the University of Bern, Switzerland.







MARTIN OHLSSON

Martin is Chief Financial Officer of the Swedish Biathlon Federation and Manager of the IBU Biathlon World Cup in Östersund, Sweden, since January 2021. Prior to joining the Swedish Biathlon Federation, he was Secretary General of the O-Ringen in Åre, one of the world's biggest orienteering events with 20'000 participants. Martin holds a Master of Science degree in Business Administration and Economics from the Umeå University in Sweden.





KIMMO TURUNEN

Since 2019, Kimmo serves as CEO at Kontiolahti Outdoor and President of the Kontiolahti Ski Club that hosts the IBU World Cup in Kontiolahti, North Karelia, Finland. He comes from an engineering background with extensive know-how in technology industrialisation, innovation management and development, and new production technology for B2C marketing. Kimmo has a degree in engineering (BEng) as well as in production technology (BASc).
